### **Deficits**

\_\_\_\_ percent of students don't know the alphabet when they enter kindergarten?

### **Deficits**

34% percent of students don't know the alphabet when they enter kindergarten.

18% percent don't know that print is read from left to right.

How many more words have children of professionals heard when they enter kindergarten than children of poverty? 30 million



### Vocabulary Gap

Children who come from professional families hear twice as many unique words and twice as many encouraging words vs. discouraging words than children of poverty.

Encouraging: What did you think of that?

Discouraging: Don't touch that!











### Increase Receptive Language: PPVT Pre-Post


- > 79% of EL Students at age 6.0+
- ▶ 98% of Non-EL students @ age 6.0 or higher






#### Increase Expressive Language: EVT Pre-Post

- Post: 78% of Non-EL at 5.0+ level; 29% of EL; 0% of any at 6.0 Level
- Both EL and Non-EL students' proficiency grew by 250%





### Number of Books Read by App Type August 2014




### Mean Letters Score by Pre/Post and Pilot v. Control

August 2014




### Mean Vocab Score by Pre/Post and Pilot v. Control

August 2014







#### Kindergarten Baseline Data





#### Growth in 1st & 2nd Grades




■1st Grade Growth
■2nd Grade Growth




### 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Literacy Test Results - Spelling


